**Calgary, AB...** Due to the overwhelming response and ticket sales for Disney's *Beauty and the Beast*, Theatre Calgary will be running for another extra week from **Tuesday, April 29 - Sunday, May 4, 2008. Tickets will be available on Friday (April 4) at 9:30am via TicketMaster.** The show must close after the matinee performance on May 4th.

Theatre Calgary's Artistic Director **Dennis Garnhum** is thrilled with the news. *"At the beginning of the season, we could not have predicted that our 40th Anniversary season would end with the longest run of a show in Theatre Calgary's history.
